Cost:	\$172 Agency Sponsored \$190 Non-agency sponsored Cost for California Residents only. Non-residents pay an additional \$181 per unit. Above non-agency fee includes an additional \$17 health fee and \$1 student rep. fee. Public Safety Training Center Classes only: Parking tickets are required unless you have an E-plated vehicle. Tickets may be purchased from vending machines in the parking lot for \$3 per day. Weekly permits for courses of one week or more can be purchased on the first day of class for \$3 per week. Cash or check only.

Course Description:	This course is designed to meet the basic requalification needs for CCW permit holders. This course is open to the general public. No more than two firearms will be allowed on your CCW permit so please limit your selection to the two firearms you wish to qualify with for the purpose of renewing your CCW.
Prerequisite:	Completion of AJ 310.1 (Concealed Firearms 24 hour course) or equivalent.

CCW Update

Required equipment and ammunition

1. A quality and functional semi-automatic pistol or a quality and functional double action revolver. The only weapon calibers allowed in this course will be: .38, .357, 9mm, .40, and .45. Five-shot revolvers are not recommended for this course of fire. There will be no .22 or .32 caliber weapons allowed .
2. At least three magazines for your semi-auto or at least two speed-loaders for your revolver.
3. Magazine or speed-loader pouches for your belt.
4. Anzi certified eye and ear protection required. (Provided on range)
5. Suitable range attire; laced athletic shoes or boots required. No sandals or slip on shoes allowed. No shorts.
6. Pens and notepaper.
7. A quality holster capable of allowing you to re-holster with one hand. We will not allow you to attend this course without a quality holster. We recommend a Fobus type holster because they are inexpensive and reliable.
8. We cannot allow any of the following: shoulder holsters, ankle holsters, cross draw holsters, fanny packs, holsters not specifically designed for your gun, holsters with antiquated flap type retention device, holsters without some form of approved retention device or strap.
9. 300 rounds of certified lead free - frangible ammunition. We recommend that you contact Load-X at (707)579-0990 or Markell Inc. at (800)550-5885 for availability and pricing. No other form of leaded ammunition will be allowed on the range. NO HOME LOADED ammunition will be allowed on the range.
10. Make sure that your firearm and equipment are clean and functioning. We will not have the ability to work on your guns or equipment during this course. If your gun has performance deficiencies you may be asked to drop the class and take it another time.
11. Range safety violations will be cause for immediate dismissal from this course. This will be at the Range Instructors discretion.
