Concealed Firearms Training

Location:	The course will be held at the Santa Rosa Junior College Public Safety Training Center, 5743 Skylane Blvd., Windsor, CA 95492. Map and directions are attached.
Course Description:	This course is designed to meet and exceed the basic training requirements for citizens who are interested in seeking application for a concealed firearms permit (CCW). This course is open to the general public and is taught as a basic firearms program. Basic firearms safety and marksmanship skills are a prerequisite and mandatory in order to attend this course. Participants are required to provide the following equipment and ammunition as identified on page two of this announcement.

Required equipment and ammunition:

1. A quality and functional semi-automatic pistol or a quality and functional double action revolver. The only weapon calibers allowed in this course will be: .38, .357, 9mm, .40, and .45. **There will be no .22 or .32 caliber weapons allowed.**
2. At least three magazines for your semi-auto or at least two speed-loaders for your revolver.
3. Magazine or speed-loader pouches for your belt.
4. Anzi certified eye and ear protection required.
5. Suitable range attire – laced athletic shoes or boots required; no sandals or slip on shoes allowed.
6. Pens and notepaper.
7. A quality holster capable of allowing you to re-holster with one hand. We will not allow you to attend this course without a quality holster. We recommend a Fobus type holster because they are inexpensive and reliable. Please bring your holster with you the first night of class so that we can inspect them.
8. We cannot allow any of the following: shoulder holsters, ankle holsters, cross draw holsters, fanny packs, holsters not specifically designed for your gun, holsters with an antiquated flap type retention device, clam shells, holsters without some form of approved retention device strap or snap.
9. 600 rounds of certified lead free frangible ammunition. We recommend that you contact Load-X or Markell Inc. (numbers below) for availability and pricing. No other form of leaded ammunition will be allowed on the range. **NO HOME LOADED** ammunition will be allowed on the range.
10. Make sure that your firearm and equipment are clean and functioning. We will not have the ability to work on your guns or equipment during this course. If your gun has performance deficiencies you may be asked to drop the class and take it another time.
11. Please **DO NOT** bring your guns to the classroom portion of this course. You will not need them until the first range day.
12. Range safety violations will be cause for immediate dismissal from this course. This will be at the Range Instructors discretion.

Take Highway 101 north to the Shiloh Road exit in Windsor. At the light, turn left and continue over the freeway and past the railroad track to Skylane Blvd. Turn left on Skylane and continue to the Public Safety Training Center on the right hand side of the road.

From North of Santa Rosa:
