Cost:	<p>\$158 Agency Sponsored \$176 Non-Agency Cost for California Residents only. Non-residents pay an additional \$181 per unit. Above non agency fee includes an additional \$17 health fee and \$1 student rep. fee.</p> <p>Public Safety Training Center Classes only: Parking tickets are required unless you have an E-plated vehicle. Tickets may be purchased from vending machines in the parking lot for \$3 per day. Temporary permits for courses of one week or more can be purchased on the first day of class for \$3 per week. This may be done online or in person. Students who are not currently enrolled at Santa Rosa Junior College or who have not taken classes at the college in the last year must complete a new application for admission prior to registering.</p>
Payment:	Payment can be made by credit card (Visa or MasterCard) or check payable to Santa Rosa Junior College. Payments can be made in advance or at the door. Agencies can be billed after the course upon request.
Medical Clearance	<p>Students will be required to participate in physical conditioning two to three times a week during the course. Practical testing will include a fifteen minute enhanced cardiovascular exercise, wind sprints, 165 lb. dummy drag, and self-contained breathing apparatus (S.C.B.A.)</p> <p>Trainees will be required to provide a medical clearance from their physicians allowing them to physically participate in the Physical Conditioning segment of the course. Employing agencies may provide a letter certifying the employee's fitness in lieu of a physician's clearance.</p>

Course Description:

This course is prescribed by the California Standards and Training for Corrections(STC) program. It is designed to provide basic training to entry-level corrections officers who work in local corrections agencies.

Uniforms

All students in this course are required to be in uniform. Agency-sponsored trainees will wear their normal duty uniform and duty belt and meet all agency uniform requirements.

Non-sponsored trainees must purchase uniforms as follows

1. Grey-colored uniform shirts (long or short sleeved) with training center patch on left shoulder. Short Sleeve (SP24 LA). Long Sleeve (SP14LA). (Equivalent to Ranger Academy specifications.)
2. Black pants with black leather belt, black socks and black plain leather shoes or boots. Flying Cross style #49410 or equivalent.

For physical training, trainees will wear navy blue sweat gear (t-shirt, shorts, sweat shirt and pants. T-shirt with Training Center Logo silk screened 4"x4" gold on left chest and last name applied in white 2" letters front and back (Equivalent to Police Academy specifications Haines #1570 short sleeve). Footwear of athletic shoes and white sweat socks is required.

Each student must arrive on the first day of class in uniform and have navy blue p.t. gear available.
