### **BASIC POLICE ACADEMY – MODULAR FORMAT 2010**

Santa Rosa Junior College is now testing for the **JANUARY 9th – DECEMBER 2nd, 2010** Basic Police Academy – Modular Format.

This module-based, extended format course meets from 6:30 pm to 10:30 pm Tuesdays and Thursdays, 8:00 am to 5:00 pm Saturdays, and occasional Sundays.

**Module III** – AJ 200.12 - Provides PC832 peace powers and Level III reserve peace officer certification (**01/9/10-03/20/10**).

**Module II** – AJ 200.113 - Provides Level II reserve peace officer certification (**03/23/10 - 07/01/10**).

**Module I** - AJ 200.14 - Provides full basic police academy certification for Level I reserve peace officer or full-time peace officer status (**07/06/10-12/02/10**).

The Academy teaches criminal law, laws of search and seizure, laws of evidence, traffic laws, investigative techniques, patrol procedures, firearms, driver training, defensive tactics, first aid, CPR and more.

The Academy is certified by the California Commission on Peace Officer Standards and Training (P.O.S.T.). Successful completion of this course will make you eligible for employment as a regular or reserve police officer or deputy sheriff anywhere in California, depending on the modules completed.

These are the only orientation dates scheduled --- all interested applicants must attend the orientation on one of these dates, or by appointment with the Academy Director. This orientation will explain the selection process and provide an overview of the course. The P.O.S.T. reading and writing test will be held immediately after the orientation.

If you have taken the P.O.S.T. reading and writing test at the Training Center or other location within one year of the start of the academy, you do not need to retest if you scored T-42 or higher.

The class will be held at our facility in Windsor. All your travel, transportation and accommodation arrangements should be made with this in mind when you consider enrolling in this class you:

- \* Must complete course orientation at scheduled orientation session or by appointment.
- \* Must POSSESS a valid driver's license at time of the class.
- \* Must pass the P.O.S.T. Reading/Writing Test with a score of T42 or higher by start of Module II. Must present photo I.D. at the time of testing.
- \* Must be eligible to register as a student at Santa Rosa Junior College without a waiver of College regulations.
- \* Must pass a California Department of Justice criminal records check (cost varies). Non-residents must also pass an FBI criminal records check at an additional cost.
- \* Must pass a medical examination by start of Module I.
- \* Must be a high school graduate or possess a G.E.D. certificate.
- \* Certain Academy uniforms and equipment are required for each module. The College may be able to loan pistol and duty belt. **(approximate total equipment cost \$2000).**
- \* California resident course costs: **Module III** - \$507.00; **Module II** \$957.00  
**Module I** - \$978.00  
Non resident course costs: \$190.00 per unit in addition to enrollment fee.
